Text for the month: 1 Cor 14:40 but all things should be done decently and in order.

Tim says: This month sees the one "regular" business meeting that our church holds. Our AGM will be held on Nov 15th, preceded by coffee/tea and nibbles, and I want to encourage ALL of you to be there. Just because we will be dealing with business matters, it is no less an integral part of our worship. 1 Cor 14:40 tells us that things should be done 'decently and in order in the church'. which is why we hold this annual meeting. We want to inform you how we have seen God leading us & using us as a church, how we have tried to achieve the objectives we set 12 months earlier, and where we see ourselves going in the next 12 months. It is necessary and correct that we report on the church finances, and also report on changes in membership. Additionally, every three years we ask you to confirm our leaders in office; and this AGM is the year that we need to do that. This enables you to express your view in a secret ballot as to the suitability of your leaders to the tasks that we face. This function is restricted to existing members, and if you are unsure as to your status we can tell you. Of course you also have the chance to ask questions, which we ask you to put in writing by the 7th November, so that we can give a considered response to you. This whole event can sound un-important, even un-spiritual, but I assure you that it is not! The church is God's plan for the world, and as such we have to do things correctly. We are stewards of all that both he, and you have given us to be stewards of, and a watching world is in the wings to hold us to account if we fail to do things right. Just as tithing is a highly spiritual activity, so is the reporting and administering of the church! Paul says that we are ALL part of the body (i.e. the Church) and we all have a role to play. Some have ministry gifts, some have practical gifts, but where we all come together is in ensuring that the church is properly and carefully run. No one is exempt from this responsibility, so please come and join us on November 15th!
